Dry it out and then you can throw it out in your trash.

- Use an absorbent like cat litter, shredded paper or saw dust to absorb the liquid and let it dry out
- Remove the top and let it air dry and harden
- Use a paint hardener

Latex paint is not a hazardous waste. It is a water-based paint that can be dried out and disposed of in your trash. However, it is important to follow proper disposal procedures to prevent environmental damage. The Monongalia County Solid Waste Authority provides information on how to properly dispose of latex paint. This includes drying out the paint, removing the top, and using a paint hardener.
