- A lesson plan and materials can be supplied to teachers who would like to teach the lesson and submit contest entries on their own. We can arrange to pick up the contest entries from your school.
- Each entry will be entered in the MCSWA 2024 calendar contest. MCSWA Board members and Administrator Lynn Castro will select the winning entries.
